The **Save Europe Act** is a European Citizens' Initiative campaign that seeks to gather one million signatures from citizens across the European Union. The initiative aims to bring the issue of **remigration and migration policy** before the European Commission and trigger a **formal political debate** at the European level.

## WHAT IS A EUROPEAN CITIZENS' INITIATIVE?

A European Citizens' Initiative is a mechanism that allows EU citizens to **propose legislation** directly to the European Commission.

If an initiative collects **one million valid signatures** from EU citizens across the required number of Member States, the European Commission must formally examine the proposal and meet with its organizers.

## WHY THE SAVE EUROPE ACT?

The Save Europe Act was created to provide European citizens with a direct democratic instrument to **express their views** on migration policy and related issues.

The campaign seeks to unite supporters from across Europe around a common set of policy proposals and demonstrate public support for those proposals through a **transparent signature campaign**.

## FOUNDERS

### EVA VLAARDINGERBROEK

Eva Vlaardingerbroek is a Dutch political commentator, lawyer, and public speaker known for her advocacy on issues relating to **European identity, democracy, national sovereignty, and migration policy**. Born in Amsterdam, she studied law at Utrecht University and later specialized in legal philosophy at Leiden University.
